Action: Drop in sessions will continue through the consultation period.

Post Office require more window posters and Questionnaires. LP/CS to drop some in. RD provided a list of footpaths and pointed out 3 posts on the proposed road line which indicated mine shafts.

CS has spoken to some travellers and has left some information for them. Most were aware of the proposal.

GB went through map of proposed routes with overlays provided by Jacki Berri (JB) prepared for the NP meeting. This was produced from data JB had elicited from the BRERC site. It was pointed out there was no mention of air quality - JB to investigate. Also noise areas not shown on the constraints map - this would particularly affect Shortwood.

Martin Smith (MS) is looking at traffic elements and traffic flow.

GB and David Savage looking at environment.

Historic England have confirmed lack of evidence re buried archaeology etc - not referenced as heritage impact.

Community Engagement – South Gloucestershire Council

Notification of consultation on M4 Junction 18a options

A consultation launched on Monday 21 August, which will help inform a feasibility study into options for a new motorway junction, 18a, to link the M4 with the A4174 ring road.

The consultation is running until Monday 16 October and everyone with an interest in the new junction is encouraged to have their say by completing a survey.

We are asking residents and businesses for their views on two options: a Western route and an Eastern route.

Western route

This route would use Westerleigh Road and the A4174 ring road adjacent to Lyde Green in Emersons Green. This would mean the new Junction 18a could be located to the north west of the Lyde Green development. It would require some realignment to the M4 itself.

Eastern route

This route explores the potential of building a link road and junction to the north and west of Pucklechurch. This would require the creation of a new link road, but a new motorway junction could be accommodated without the need to realign the M4.
