

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(ABSON ROAD, WICK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE BY VEHICLES) ORDER
2020

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles that length of Abson Road which extends from its junction with Holbrook Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of 500 metres (ie outside the substation).

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon mains power reinforcement scheme works and will be operative from the 19 October 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **4 weeks** duration.
