Details of the proposed changes

NOTICE is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council proposes to make an order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle entering, proceeding or waiting in that length of **Coxgrove Hill**, Lyde Green which extends from its junction with Henfield Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 200 metres.

Exemptions are contained in the order for vehicles to be used for building, industrial or demolition operations; the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road; the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the road of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunication apparatus; in the service of a local authority, for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in exercise of official duties and for the purpose of gaining access to premises accessible only from that length of road. A further exemption will be included for pedal cycles.

Background
